- Implemented at the GPO
 - Supports version 2 of the API
 - In use by portal and omni 2.5
- Implemented at Utah ProtoGENI
 - Supports version 1, currently alpha
- Omni knows how to invoke the Federation API
 - Use framework “chapi”

- Identical API available at ProtoGENI and GPO
 - And other federation services in the future
- Richer set of calls than previously available
 - Project information
 - Slice membership
 - Key management (SSH)
- XML-RPC API over client-authenticated TLS
 - Same infrastructure as Aggregate Manager (AM) API
 - As secure as AM API

- Support for “speaks for” authorization
 - Lets hosted tools act on behalf of users
 - Users maintain control of their private key
- Capability discovery through `get_version()`
 - Services declare which sets of features are implemented
 - Tools can dynamically adjust

- Access to sliver information
 - Slivers per slice per aggregate
 - Note: advisory, not authoritative
 - Currently only a few tools report info (portal, omni)
 - Better to get info from aggregates
- International adoption gives tools a wider audience
 - Tools can be used on non-GENI testbeds
 - Tools from other testbeds can be used in GENI
